

NOTICE

Please read this carefully before installing your new Dawson Precision competition follower and/or STI magazine spring. Improper installation will result in undesired results.

When using a Dawson Precision competition follower we recommend it be used with a STI spring or comparable spring profile. Other springs may cause malfunction or decreased performance.

To install a Dawson Precision STI competition follower, the magazine spring must first be trimmed for proper fit. Please use the template below to mark and cut your spring. This diagram is from the perspective of looking down on the top of the spring.

1. Hold spring with the top facing up and front of spring facing away from you.
2. Slide this card under the first radius at the top of the spring. Align spring with diagram. (Spring may require minor bending to align exactly). Use permanent felt marker to mark the spring at the indicated "cut" point.
3. Cut the spring at the marked point. If unsure, cut the spring long and measure again. (You can always cut off more.)
4. If the cut is at the desired length, check for burrs. If there are any, use a small file or nail file to remove imperfections.
5. Snap follower into spring and go have fun while experiencing another fine innovation from Dawson Precision.
